RULE IV – MEMBERSHIP

- a) Membership of the Club shall be open to anyone interested in the sport on application regardless of sex, age, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs. However, limitation of membership according to available facilities is allowable on a non-discriminatory basis.
- b) Memberships in the Club are individual and non-transferable.
- c) The Club may have different classes of membership and subscription on a non-discriminatory and fair basis.
- d) The Council may refuse membership, or remove it, only for good cause such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or the sport into disrepute. Appeal against refusal of membership may be made in writing to the General Manager within 21 days of the application being refused. A specially convened Appellant Committee, of at least three members, not comprising Council members will then re-consider the application.
- e) Memberships in the Club are for one year only, with memberships expiring on the 31 December.
- f) The fiscal year for the Club will be 1 January through to 31 December.
- g) There shall be two classes of membership:
 - A golfing member being a person who has been accepted as a member of the Club on payment of the appropriate annual subscription or who has been elected as a Life/Honorary member. Only this class of member may vote at General Meetings.
 - A Social member being a person who has been accepted as a non-playing member of the Club on payment of the reduced annual subscription.

The Council may from time to time determine classes of membership within the above classes and the conditions applying to those classes.

- h) The Council may confer Honorary membership upon those who they feel have contributed to the advancement of golf or served the Club in an exemplary manner. The unanimous affirmative vote of the Council shall be required to approve such action.
- i) Every candidate for playing membership of the Club shall make his application in writing, signed by the candidate on the approved form.

Following the application being received by the General Manager, including his personal details, and consents under EU Data Protection Regulations and have then been registered on the Club's systems, the subscription payment or part thereof must be paid within 14 days. The payment binds the member to comply with these Rules. If a candidate fails to pay the subscription within 14 days of the date of request for payment, the candidate's election to membership shall be void unless he can satisfy the Council that there was reasonable cause for failure.

- j) The annual subscriptions shall be at such rates as shall from time to time be determined by the Council and posted in accordance with the rules in order for members to vote at General Meeting accordingly.
- k) The Council may permit subscriptions to be paid by installments on such terms as it shall, in its absolute discretion, decide.
- l) New membership joining after the 1 January each year will be charged the annual membership fee which will be adjusted on a pro-rata monthly basis.
- m) **The annual subscription or first installment thereof shall become due and payable on the 1 January each year. Any member who fails to pay his subscription or the first installment thereof by 30 April in any year shall automatically cease to be a member of the club, but shall remain liable for all monies due from him.**
- n) Any member wishing to resign shall notify the Club on or before the 31 December, otherwise shall be in default, of which he shall be liable for the ensuing year's subscription.
- o) In the event that any member of the Club shall commit any act which reflects discredit or disrepute thereon or shall refuse or neglect to comply with the Rules and Regulations adopted by the Council or duly appointed Officers, such member shall be subject to suspension or expulsion after 14 days written notice. The right to be heard, by a vote of two thirds of the Council or at a specially convened Appellant Committee, of at least three members, not comprising of Council members.

Any member so expelled shall not afterwards be admissible into the Club premises as a visitor or guest nor shall be eligible for re-election.

Any member expelled from membership or otherwise ceasing to be a member of the Club shall forfeit all right to any claim upon the Club or its property or funds or any return of fees and shall remain liable for any outstanding fees or charges due from him at the date of expulsion or cessation.

- p) All members shall show courtesy and consideration to all other members whilst using the Club's facilities. Where necessary any disputes between members will in the first instance be taken up by the General Manager and respective Captain(s). Should any of these be unavailable the Chairman will arrange an appropriate Council member to act in their place.
- q) Any member shall have the right to introduce personal guests to the clubhouse. Members are responsible for the behavior of their personal guests. Visiting players in competitions and accompanying officials, whilst guests of the Club, are not regarded as personal guests.
- r) Members are responsible for communicating their address, email address and contact numbers and any other changes to the General Manager. All notices sent to them at their address shall be considered duly delivered.

In accordance with the Data Protection Regulations the Club may wish to publish an internal membership handbook, yearbook or directory. This would include member's (or in the case of a family membership the lead family member's) name, email addresses, home phone and mobile number and will be available to all members, in either electronic or paper versions. If you consent to your data being shared in this way, **please tick here.**

Please be aware that if you later decide to withdraw consent to your contact details being published it will not be possible to remove your contact details from printed material until such time as the next edition of the handbook is printed, which will be on a yearly basis.
