Prestatyn Golf Club - Local Rules

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** (Rule 18.2)
 - a) Within confines of the Clubhouse and car park.
 - b) Over any fence or hedge.
 - c) The area of the practice ground and short game area denoted by white posts with black tops.
 - d) In or over the gutter on the 8th, 9th, 10th, 12th, 13th and 18th holes.
 - e) In the gutter crossing the 1st and 11th holes.
 - f) At the 18th hole on or over the road on the left hand side of the fairway between the white marker posts and the east end of the car park, also through the green in or over the ditch denoted by the white marker posts.
 - g) At the back of the 6th hole denoted by white marker posts.
 - h) On the 3rd and 16th, over the white posts, on the left hand side of the fairway

2. **THE ROAD**

A ball lying in bounds, on or within one club-length of the road crossing the 17th and 18th fairways, may be lifted and dropped without penalty, one club-length away from the road, provided the road is kept between the ball and hole being played.

Note: If impractical to comply at the immediate entrance to the club, the nearest point allowing relief not nearer the hole should be taken.

3. **PENALTY AREAS** (Rule 17)
Penalty areas are defined by red or yellow stakes.
4. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** - The following are immovable obstructions and Rule 16 applies: shelters, paths, seats and benches, bridges, steps, direction posts, sprinkler heads or valve on or within two club-lengths of the green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between ball and hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty as follows:
If the ball lies off the green but not in a penalty area and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which:
 - a) is not nearer the hole.
 - b) avoids such intervention and
 - c) is not in a penalty area or on a green.
5. Telegraph poles and the supporting wires are an integral part of the course.
